OMPS After Care Discipline Policy

In order to provide a safe and enjoyable camp experience for all campers, there are specific behavioral guidelines that must be followed. Participants are expected to exhibit appropriate behaviors at all times. Camp staff will reinforce appropriate behavior through positive reinforcement and care. All campers must understand the behavioral expectations. Please review the guidelines with your child.

- Be safe! Follow all camp rules
- Use appropriate language towards campers and staff
- Show respect and kindness to all campers and staff
- Treat equipment with care and respect
- Aggressive behavior will not be tolerated
- Be positive and have a great time!

Listed below are the discipline procedures for campers who are exhibiting unsafe and/or aggressive behaviors. If the behavior is aggressive, some steps may be skipped.

Step 1 - Verbal Warning

Step 2 - Break from activity: student's parents will be notified of the break.

Step 3 - Written Warning: In repeated or unacceptable behavior, parents will be given a written warning and the camper will be required to be picked up for the rest of the camp day. **No refunds will be given.**
