**Curriculum**

We designed our program with a wholesome focus on physical, social, emotional, language and intellectual development. Each child's physical growth and progress will be monitored. Large and small motor skills will be practiced every day. In addition, we will encourage your child to play and interact appropriately with others. Your child will learn to cooperate, care and accept both peers and adults. Your child will develop self respect and confidence as we monitor his/her social and emotional skills.

Language development occurs as your child begins to listen, speak, read and write. We will introduce these skills and nurture your child's development in these areas. Intellectual or cognitive development occurs as we support your child in his/her thinking processes. We will problem-solve in both directed activities and free play opportunities. We will introduce your child to writing, math, science and other areas of cognitive development.

Finally, we will teach your child to appreciate his/her humble beginning. We believe each child is a promise. Your child will learn that he/she is loved through caring interactions and altruistic actions. Your child will understand what it means to help and care for each other. Because diversity is an important component in our community, we will explore many cultural traditions with your child. Cultural norms reflect the ways things are done in a child's family and community. Because culture is so important, teachers need to learn and respect its influence on the children in the classroom. Teachers are expected to familiarize themselves with the children's families to understand the different family environments and culture. Teachers will then, use this information in their classrooms as they create their lesson plans: materials, topics and strategies.
